Guidelines for Receiving the 2024 Brantley County Chamber of Commerce "Create Your Way" Financial Award

The **Create Your Way Award** was created to provide a financial benefit to graduating seniors from Brantley County High School. The Brantley County Chamber of Commerce seeks to administer this award, including collection of funds, oversight of selection, and award presentation in this inaugural year and subsequent years, as funding allows. Initial financial support for the award was provided by a group of area "creators," artisans, entrepreneurs, business leaders, and community members who value creative minds and ingenuity. This award is given with the realization that excellence and genius is demonstrated in a variety of forms. The Create Your Way award seeks to foster characteristics such as creativity and strategic planning, which can transform communities.

The following criteria will apply:

- 1. Demonstrated history of application of talents for innovation, creation, invention, creative solutions, business prowess and/or effecting change.
- 2. Be in academic good-standing upon graduation.
- 3. Demonstrate qualities of an upstanding citizen (e.g., law-biding, ethical in interactions, respectful of others).
- 4. Complete an application form, and answer the included questions, with total application not to exceed the current number of (5) pages total.
- 5. Agreement to applying the award towards educational endeavors, training expenses, or for initiation of a business venture to prepare for implementation of future creative endeavors.

The Brantley An Advisory committee will select the scholarship winner which will be subject to the approval of the Brantley County Chamber of Commerce. Selection will be based on content of responses and will rated blindly, with no identifying information included. *No member of the Advisory Committee, Chamber of Commerce, or his or her immediate family, shall be eligible for scholarship assistance during his or her tenure.*

Applications should be postmarked or submitted to the Brantley County Chamber of Commerce (Drawer B, Nahunta, Georgia 31553) by Friday, May 3, 2024. The award will be presented at the Brantley County High School Honors Night.
